A. Hong Kong Ski & Snowboard Team Selection

A1. Hong Kong Ski Team Selection - Future Star Member

1. Eligibility

- 1.1 Must be a Hong Kong resident or holder of a HKID card.
- 1.2 Age 8 to 11.

2. Selection Method to join HK Ski Team (Future Star Member)

- 2.1 Performance at one of our Future Star Assessments OR
- 2.2 Recommended by Ski Club Professionals/Coaches recognized by SA-HK OR
- 2.3 Selection Criteria include race results, evaluation of technique, athletic ability, communication skills, personal behavior etc. OR
- 2.4 Race results from Hong Kong National Ski & Snowboard Championships.

A2. Hong Kong Ski Team Selection – Bronze Badge Member

1. Eligibility

- 1.1 Must be a Hong Kong resident or holder of a HKID card.
- 1.2 Age 12 and above

1.3 Promoted from Future Star Member when age is 12.

2. Selection Method to join HK Ski Team (Bronze Badge Member)

2.1 Performance at one of our General Assessments OR

2.2 Recommended by Ski Club Professionals/Coaches recognized by SA-HK OR

2.3 Selection Criteria include race results, evaluation of technique, athletic ability, communication skills, personal behavior etc. OR

2.4 Race results from Hong Kong National Ski & Snowboard Championships.

2.5 Responsibility of Bronze Badge Member

(a) Must attend at least one (1) overseas race.

(b) Must attend at least one (1) overseas training organized either by SA-HK or recognized ski clubs.

A3. Hong Kong Ski Team Selection – Silver Badge Member

1. Eligibility

1.1 Must be a Hong Kong resident or holder of a HKID card.

1.2 Age 12 and above.

1.3 Promoted from Bronze Badge Member.

2. Selection Method to join HK Ski Team (Silver Badge Member)

2.1 Performance at one of our General Assessments OR

2.2 Recommended by Ski Club Professionals/Coaches recognized by SA-HK OR

2.3 Selection Criteria include race results, evaluation of technique, athletic ability, communication skills, personal behavior etc. OR

2.4 Race results from Hong Kong National Ski & Snowboard Championships.

2.5 Responsibility of Silver Badge Member

(a) Must attend at least two (2) overseas races.

(b) Must attend at least two (2) overseas training organized either by SA-HK or recognized ski clubs.

A4. Hong Kong Ski Team Selection – Gold Badge Member

1. Eligibility

1.1 Must be a Hong Kong resident or holder of a HKID card.

1.2 Age 12 and above.

1.3 Promoted from Silver Badge Member.

2. Selection Method to join HK Ski Team (Gold Badge Member)

2.1 Recommended by Ski Club Professionals/Coaches recognized by SA-HK OR

2.2 Selection Criteria include race results, evaluation of technique, athletic ability, communication skills, personal behavior etc. OR

2.4 Race results from overseas races

2.5 Responsibility of Gold Badge Member

(a) Must attend at least Three (3) overseas races.

(b) Must attend at least Three (3) overseas training organized either by SA-HK or recognized ski clubs.

B. Race Selection Process

1. SA-HK will circulate approved race lists to relevant members of the Hong Kong Ski Team;
2. The team list of each race will be developed and approved by the Selection Committee;
3. SA-HK will inform team members of the number of spots available, race information, departure and return dates and specific selection criteria for this race, and request them to reply in writing regarding their availability by a specified date;
4. The Selection Committee will select from the available team members based on the specific criteria for each race;
5. SA-HK will inform the selected skiers and announce the selection results to the rest of the team.
6. Race Selection Criteria: (a) Entry requirements set by the race organizer; (b) FIS Ranking if any, (c) Race results and overall performance of the skier up to the selection date, (d) Participation and commitment to the team, (e) Discipline and attitude of the player, (f) Selection Committee may consider skier who have had recent outstanding results, (g) Selection Committee reserves the right to make the final decision as to whether or not to send players to overseas races.

C. Selection Committee Members

1. SA-HK Chairman
2. SA-HK Secretary General
3. SA-HK Oversea Director
4. SA-HK National Head Coach
5. SF&OC Selection Committee for all International Games such as Winter Olympic Game and Asian Winter Game.

D. Right of Appeal

1. Member of the Hong Kong Ski & Snowboard Team may appeal the decision of the Selection Committee to the Executive Committee by giving a written notice to SA-HK within 14 days of the date of decision by the Selection Committee being communicated to him/her.
2. Upon receiving the request, the Executive Committee must determine whether to:
 - 2.1 Dismiss the appeal; or
 - 2.2 Convene a hearing in relation to the appeal.
 - 2.3. In the event of a hearing, the Executive Committee will hear the appeal at such a time and in such a manner as the Executive Committee deems appropriate. A quorum of at least three members of the Executive Committee must be present to hear an appeal.

E. Hearing

1. If the Executive Committee determines to convene a hearing in relation to the appeal, it must give at least 14 days written notice to the player stating: (a) The date, time and place at which it will hear and determine the appeal; (b) That the player is entitled to be assisted or represented by one other

person or parent (if the player is Under 18 years of age).

2. If the member is not present at the hearing, the Executive Committee may: (a) Proceed to hear and determine the appeal; or (b) Adjourn the hearing of the appeal for such period determined by the Executive Committee and must give written notice of the time and place when the hearing will resume.
3. If the member is present, he/she may give evidence and bring any relevant witnesses to support his/her case.
4. After the presentation of evidence and hearing any final submissions by the member the Executive Committee shall make such determination as it shall see fit in the circumstances.
5. The decision of the Executive Committee will, in its discretion, either be: (a) Announced at the conclusion of the appeal; or (b) Communicated in writing to the member within 30 days of the conclusion of the appeal.
6. The Executive Committee's decision is final.

F. Fees

1. Members of the Hong Kong Ski and Snowboard Team will be charged with an Administration Fee of HK\$1,000 for the 2019-2020 season (1st of September, 2019 to 31st of August, 2020). Payment of Administration Fee must be made before 20th September, 2019. Otherwise membership with Hong Kong Ski and Snowboard Team will be suspended without notice.
2. Fee of Future Star Assessment (age 8 to 11) for the 2019-2020 season is HK\$2,000.
3. Fee of General Assessment (age 12 or above) for 2019-2020 season is HK\$3,000.

G. Official Clothing

1. Official Clothing Partner of Hong Kong Ski and Snowboard Team for 2019-2020 is Artica. Members of the Hong Kong Ski and Snowboard Team must wear official clothing provided by Artica if any at any FIS event. Otherwise, their membership as well as their FIS Code will be suspended without notice.
2. For major events such as the Winter Olympic Games managed by SF&OC Hong Kong, official clothing will be provided. Selected members from the Hong Kong Ski & Snowboard Team who do not wear those official clothing will have their memberships as well as FIS Codes suspended without notice.

H. Entering FIS Races

1. Members of the Hong Kong Ski & Snowboard Team who would like to enter any FIS races must first report to SA-HK office who will then enter that event for them. Those who enter FIS events without authorization from SA-HK will be suspended from their team membership as well as their FIS Code.

Note: SA-HK reserves the right to amend the above rules and regulations from time to time.
