In order to facilitate our growing list of talented athletes, SA-HK organized meaningful trainings and strong teams for competition all over the world, travelling to a multitude of places, including; Inner Mongolia, Jilin, Guangzhou, Switzerland, Norway, Slovenia, Croatia and Bosnia, Italy, Chile and France. In addition, SA-HK broke ground by signing a historic agreement with the City of East Sarajevo and the Jahorina Olympic Sports Center. Thereby, securing a relationship of cooperation, community and resources, moving towards the Beijing 2022 Winter Olympic Games, and our future as an association.

SA-HK began the 2019/2020 season with our first training session in the Guangzhou Sunac Snow Park, establishing it as one of our primary training bases in Asia. Following that event, we organized another key training event and annual interschool ski & snowboard competition, with the participation of 14 schools in Club Med Beidahu in Jilin China which is our training venue partner. Finally, following many smaller, targeted, training trips, we hosted our first training and Hong Kong National Championships in Jahorina, Bosnia. Which will also serve as a primary training base for "Train to Compete" in the foreseeable future. In addition to training, SA-HK athletes competed in multiple competitions around the world, including; the China National Winter Games (Alpine) in Inner Mongolia China, Winter Youth Olympic in Switzerland, Pokal Loka FIS Children Ski Competition in Slovenia, Narvik Norway World Junior Championship in Norway. Attending these competitions has been reflective of SA-HK's growth as an association, as our athletes have been able to qualify for such prestigious events.

Going into our 2020/2021 season, I am hopeful that we shall be able to resume our high level of training and competitions, in the hopes of preparing for the upcoming 2022 Winter Olympic Games held in our capital city Beijing, China. I would like to take this opportunity to thank our athletes for their patience during this challenging time and their continued determination, and to wish them the best of luck going into this new season. Finally, I would like to thank you all for your continuous support of SA-HK. Every member, whether athlete, contributor, sponsor, parent or coach has helped make SA-HK what it is today. Your contribution to this association has been invaluable, and has aided in its growth and growing success on the international winter stage.

The training comprised of hours on the slopes, as well as technical knowlege breakdowns of the physics of skiing and pre-competition equipment preparation tips for each individual athlete. 




## TRAINING PARTNER AGREEMENT SIGNING WITH SUNAC SNOW PARK GUANGZHOU 2019

Following the 2019 Annual Dinner, SA-HK began our 2019/2020 season with SA-HK Chairman Edmond Yue, signing a crucial agreement with the Guangzhou Sunac Snow Park on the October 25th 2019, establishing a new training base and partner for SA-HK. The snow park is one of the largest and well-renowned indoor ski facilities in the world. With this new partnership, SA-HK is looking to provide our athletes with unprecedented and convenient access to this training facility, just two hours outside of Hong Kong. From this season onwards, multiple trainings will be held at this facility in order to provide our athletes all-year-round training for ski and snowboard.







#### PRE-SEASON TRAINING IN GUANGZHOU 2019

Following the signing of the partnership agreement between SA-HK and Guangzhou Sunac Snow Park, SA-HK held it's first pre-season training of the year. 




#### FIS CHILDREN SKI RACE BJELASNICA, BOSNIA 2020


